The West Valley Sanitation District is currently recruiting for a Maintenance Worker I to perform tasks associated with operation and maintenance of sanitary sewer and storm drain systems.

Minimum Employment Standards:

High School diploma or GED. One year of work experience in construction and/or maintenance work. Possess knowledge of practices, techniques and materials used in maintenance, construction, and repair of sanitary sewer systems, storm drains, and related tasks. Valid California Class C or higher driver's license and DMV record that meets District's standards. Class A license with tanker endorsement must be obtained within 6 months of appointment.

Possession of a Grade 1 Collection Systems Maintenance Certificate issued by California Water Environment Association is desirable. Completion of the Ken Kerri (Office of Water Programs-Sacramento State University) coursework in the Operation and Maintenance of Wastewater Collection Systems, Volume 1 and/or Volume 2 is also desirable.

Application and Selection Procedure:

Applications will be reviewed and qualified applicants will be invited to participate in an examination process to determine knowledge of equipment, materials, tools, procedures, and related items. Following the examination process, an eligibility list will be established. Prior to appointment a physical capacity evaluation will be required, as well as a medical screening, including drug and alcohol testing.
